

Selvedge Scarf



Materials:

- Fabric scraps and selvages
- Muslin (or other fabric used for backing)
- Thread
- Sewing Machine
- Ruffler Foot or Gathering Foot

Selvedge Scarf Instructions:

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1. Collect selvages and fabric scraps from other projects.
(For this particular project, you can cut selvages and fabric scraps to whatever width you prefer).
2. Ruffle each selvedge using your sewing machine and ruffler foot (or gathering foot.) Stitch directly down the middle of each fabric strip.
3. Cut a piece of muslin or other fabric to your desired dimension (for example, 12 in x 48 in.)
4. Sew each ruffled selvedge to the scarf backing. Sew down the middle seam of each ruffled selvedge. This should be fairly free form. Do your best to cover all of the scarf backing. Please note that your scarf will become thicker (and warmer) with each added selvedge.
5. Congratulations! You now have a wearable testament to your craftiness!
